## ***LAMINATE FLOORING***

## ***DOMESTIC MAINTENANCE***

### **MAINTENANCE DO'S**

- Use well-wrung mop when cleaning the floor. Use a minimal amount of methylated spirits, if a cleaning agent is required. Avoid leaving excess water on the floor to dry naturally.
- Sweep the floor regularly to avoid grit and small stones scratching or prematurely wearing the floor. Use a soft bristled broom, electrostatic mop or a vacuum cleaner with the bristles down.
- Mats at external entrances are recommended in order to minimise the amount of grit and dirt that is walked inside.
- Apply felt pads to the underside of furniture, such as legs of chairs and tables and the bases of any movable items, to protect the floor from scratching and premature wear.

### **MAINTENANCE DON'TS**

- Do not use detergents, waxes or polishes on the floor.
- Do not leave any excess water or moisture on the floor after mopping the floor,
- Do not attempt to re-coat the floor with a wax, polyurethane or oil-based finish.
- *Do not steam clean the floor.*
- Do not use scrubbing pads or abrasive pads to clean the floor or to remove any stains etc.
